

Instructions for Using These SB 59 Confidentiality Request Templates

Thank you for using these self-help templates for requesting confidentiality under Senate Bill 59. To use these templates please follow the steps below:

1. Fill out the SB 59 Confidentiality Request

Anywhere you see highlighted text in the SB 59 Confidentiality Request, delete it and type in the information that applies to you. Examples include your name, case name, county, address, and date.

2. Choose the correct proposed order for your age

There are two proposed order templates:

- SB 59 Adult Confidentiality Proposed Order
- SB 59 Minor Confidentiality Proposed Order

If you are 18 or older, use the Adult Confidentiality Proposed Order.

If you are under 18, use the Minor Confidentiality Proposed Order.

Fill out the highlighted sections in the proposed order that matches your age.

3. Do not change unhighlighted blank spaces

If a blank space is *not* highlighted, leave it as it is. You do not need to make any changes in these spaces. These spaces are for the court to complete.

4. Review everything carefully

Read through the SB 59 Confidentiality Request and the proposed order you are using. Make sure all highlighted items have been replaced and that the information is correct.

5. Print the completed documents

Once everything is filled in, print:

- The SB 59 Confidentiality Request, *and*
- The SB 59 Adult *or* Minor Confidentiality Proposed Order you completed.

6. Take your documents to your local court

Bring the printed forms to the courthouse in the county where your name and gender marker correction case is filed. The court clerk will tell you what to do next.
